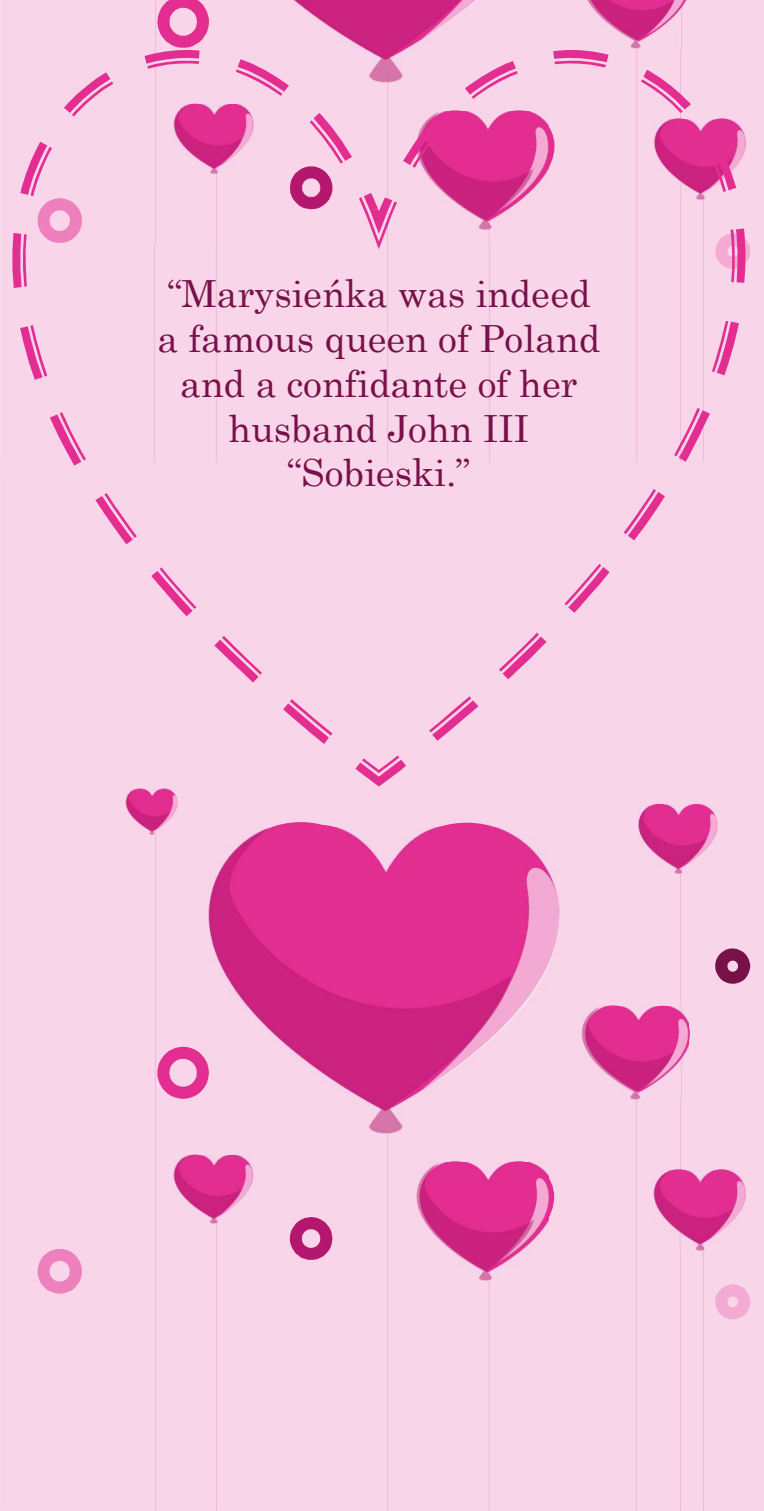


Marysienka. Mystery of Wilanów palace


