What they consist of:

- Min. 15 class hours a week of language learning
- Min. 10 class hours a week of lectures, workshops, integration events, projects
- Min. once a week trip outside town and once a week in town trip
- Didactic materials for everyone
- Additionally Meals and acommodation if on-site course.
- Additionally practical in-class workshops for the teachers.

Who is eligible:

- People who does not live nor study in Poland
- Students of foreign universities
- Academic teachers scientists
- Teachers of Polish language working at foreign universities



What is required:

- Engagment and high level of participation (frekwencja)
- Active aproach
- Health insurance and travel costs to and from Poland (refers to on-site course) – apart from that everything is free,
- Filling in the questionaire at the end of the course.

How to become a participant:

- Being appointed for the guaranted places
- Being a beneficiary of other NAWA programs
- Applying in a free call
- We try to accept all the teachers



How to apply in a free call:

- Keep checking our website to see what courses are availabe (we work hard to have that information as early as possible, but it will be a succes if we make it earlier than April)
- One persons may apply to more than one course, but may participate only in one adn
- Should make up his/her mind asap and inform all the other courses about the resignation to give the organizers the chance to invite people from the waiting list,





The Gen. Anders Programme

The Programme offers scholarships:

- for the Polish diaspora from all over the world (for holders of the Card of the Pole and people of Polish origin)
- for the first-cycle studies, second-cycle studies, as well as long-cycle studies
- for undertaking studies in Polish language (level B2 required at minimum)
- for undertaking studies without any fees at public universities supervised by the Ministry of Education and Science



The Banach Scholarship Programme

The Programme offers scholarships:

- in the field of engineering and technical sciences, agricultural sciences, exact sciences, and life sciences for the citizens of the following countries: Albania, Angola, Argentina, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Colombia, Ethiopia, Georgia, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Iran, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kosovo, Lebanon, Mexico, Moldova, Montenegro, Nigeria, North Macedonia, Palestine, Peru, the Philippines, Senegal, Serbia, South Africa, Tanzania, Tunisia, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, and Vietnam.
- In addition, the citizens of Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, Montenegro, Moldova, North Macedonia, Serbia, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan can complete second-degree studies in the fields of humanities and social sciences under the Programme, with the exception of philological studies in the field of the beneficiary's native language.

POLONISTA – scholarship and fellowship Programme

The objective of the Programme is to promote Polish language in the world by enabling foreigners interested in Polish language and Polish culture to study or carry out research projects in Poland.

Who can apply?

students and doctoral students of Polish philology, Polish studies or Polish programs implemented among others as part of Slavic studies (in the field of Polish language, Polish culture and knowledge about Poland)

scientists (researchers interested in the Polish language and culture) from foreign universities and scientific institutions

Ulam programme

- For recognized and promising scientists who hold at least a doctoral degree
- The scientists apply individually after arranging their visits with the host institutions
- A large choice of academic and research units: 392 HEIs (including 133 public), 77 institutes of Polish Academy of Sciences, 76 research institutes, Łukasiewicz research network, 2 international institutes
- Post-doctoral fellowship, conducting research or obtaining materials for research or a scientific publication



Ulam - terms and conditions

Project start date	No earlier than 1 January next year and no later than 1 October next year
Project duration	Visits can last from 6 to 24 months
Project implementation period	Should be implemented on a continuous basis. The period of stay outside the Host institution cannot be longer than 10% of the overall duration of stay

Living costs	PLN 10 000 (~EUR 2 130) per month
Mobility allowance	PLN 7 000 (European countries)
	PLN 12 000 (non-European countries)
Costs of learning Polish	Maximum PLN 5 000
Familly allowance	Spouse (PLN 2 000 per month)
	Child (PLN 1 000 per month)

- Within bilateral agreements we accept students from, inter alia, the following countries: Armenia, Belarus, Bulgaria, China, Croatia, Czech Republic, Egypt, France, Japan, Yemen, Kazakhstan, Macedonia, Mongolia, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Switzerland, Taiwan, Ukraine, Hungary, Vietnam approx. 150 beneficiaries
- The visits under the Programme may last from 3 days to 12 months in a given academic year depending on the provisions of the agreement on a basis of which cooperation is executed
- The scholarships (1250, 1500, 2200 or 3000 PLN) is paid by the University and refunded by NAWA on a basis of an agreement with the University (the amount depends on the level of studies)



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
